

ORDINANCE NO. 8909122

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF MAYPEARL, TEXAS INCLUDING PARKING ON MAIN STREET, PARALLEL PARKING ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS, ESTABLISHING NO PARKING OR LIMITED PARKING IN CITY, PROVIDING HANDICAPPED PARKING AND FOR REMOVAL OF IMPROPERLY PARKED VEHICLE AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR EACH VIOLATION; AND CONTAINING A REPEAL CLAUSE AND A SAVINGS CLAUSE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYPEARL, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: PARKING ON MAIN STREET: All motor vehicles will be park d in accordance with the accepted method of parking, (angle), on Main Street. Angle parking will be required anytime angle parking stripes are visible. Angle parking will begin approximately 100 feet past the intersection of Third Street and Main Street on the west side of Main Street and will continue up to the intersection of First Street and Main Street. Angle parking will begin at the intersection of Third Street and Main Street on the east side of Main Street and will continue to the intersection of First Street and Main Street.

SECTION 2: PARALLEL PARKING: Vehicles are permitted to parallel park on residential streets within the city limits of Mayp arl if the vehicle does not park in such a way as to constitute a traffic hazzard. In every case, two way traffic must not be hampered due to a parallel parked vehicle. Any vehicl parallel parked on any residential street must be facing the proper direction.

SECTION 3: HANDICAPPED PARKING: One handicapped parking zon will be designated on each side of Main Street. The City Council will designate these locations.

SECTION 4: REMOVAL OF IMPROPERLY PARKED VEHICLE: The Police D partment may if necessary have an improperly parked vehicle impounded if the vehicle constitutes a traffic hazzard in a residential area or if a vehicle is parallel parked in designated angle parking on Main Street.

SECTION 5: PARKING FINES: The City Police Department is authorized to issue parking citations for any vehicle in violation of this ordinance. The fine for parking in a handicapped zon without handicapped license plates will be set at \$5.00. The fine for other parking violations will be set at \$5.00.

SECTION 6: REPEAL OF ANYTHING IN CONFLICT HEREWITH. Any ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, or any part hereof, are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 7: SAVING CLAUSE: If any part, portion or section, phrase or sentence of this ordinance, should for any reason be held invalid, no other part or portion of this ordinance shall necessarily be affected thereby.
