

ORDINANCE NO. 87 12 08

AN ORDINANCE LOCATING TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS FOR THE CITY OF MAYPEARL, ELLIS COUNTY, TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYPEARL, TEXAS:

SECTION I. PURPOSE OF THE ORDINANCE.

For traffic control devices in the City of Maypearl.

SECTION II. LOCATION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS.

Traffic control devices that are currently in place at the following locations:

a. STOP SIGNS:

First & Main	(West on First)
Second & Main	(East on Second)
Third & Main	(East & West on Third)
Fourth & Main	(East & West on Fourth)
Fifth & Main	(West on Fifth)
Hwy 157 & Main	(East on Hwy 157)
Commerce & Second	(East & West on Second)
Claunch & Third	(North & South on Claunch)
Fourth & Claunch	(East & West on Fourth)
Third & Panther	(South on Panther)
Fourth & Panther	(West on Fourth)
Third & Claunch	(East & West on Third)
Fifth & Claunch	(West on Fifth)
Claunch & Hwy 157	(North on Claunch)
Trice & Hwy 157	(North on Trice)
Trice & Fourth	(North & South on Trice)
Trice & Third	(North & South on Trice)
Commerce & Third	(North & South on Commerce)
Commerce & First	(South on Commerce)
First & Main	(East on First)
Second & Main	(West on Second)
Front & Hwy 66	(West on Front)
Third & Noble	(North & South on Noble)
Creekview Hills	(Three Entrances to Hwy 66)

b. ONE WAY SIGNS:

Claunch & Second	(East on Second)
Claunch & Third	(West on Third)
Third & Phillips	(west on Third)
Panther & Third	(South on Panther)
Morton & Third	(West on Third)

SECTION III. CONFORMING WITH TEXAS V.C.S.

The City Council of the City of Maypearl hereby adopts all state statutes applying to state highway signs within the City limits of the City of Maypearl.

SECTION IV. RATIFICATION OF EXISTING DEVICES.

All traffic-control signs, signals, devices and markings placed or erected prior to the adoption of this ordinance and in use for the purpose of regulating, warning or guiding traffic are hereby affirmed, ratified and declared to be official traffic-control devices, provided such traffic control devices are not inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance or state law.

SECTION V. SEVERABILITY.

That should any word, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance be held to be void and unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect the same as if no portion of this ordinance had been held to be void and unenforcible.
