RESOLUTION NO. 2022-1116

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYPEARL, TEXAS ESTABLISHING A REGULAR MONTHLY CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE CITY OF MAYPEARL, TEXAS TO BE HELD ON THE FIRST MONDAY OF EACH AND EVERY MONTH.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Maypearl, Texas currently holds its regular monthly City Council meeting on the second Monday of each and every month; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Maypearl, Texas desires to instead establish a regular monthly City Council meeting on the first Monday of each and every month.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYPEARL, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Maypearl, Texas hereby establishes a regular monthly City Council meeting to be held on the first Monday of each and every month, beginning the first Monday of December, 2022. If City Hall is closed for a holiday on the first Monday of the month, then the monthly City Council meeting shall be held on the first Tuesday of that month.

SECTION 2. That to the extent any resolution previously adopted by the City Council conflicts with the provisions of this Resolution, the same are hereby repealed, and all other provisions not in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this resolution be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this resolution as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
